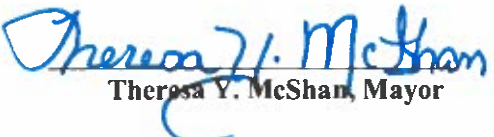
Mayor McShan adjourned the Executive Session and Reconvened into Open Session at 8:11 p.m.
