- Roll Call
  - Chief Chris Noble

- Committee Member Susie Alvarado motions to excuse Chairperson Mike Walterscheidt and Secretary Tim Brooks. Committee Member Bryce Hatley seconds the motion.
- Secretary Tim Brooks arrived late.
- Public Comment

- Chief's Update
  - Status of New Police Station:
    - Discussed the arrival of the Certificate of occupancy, furniture installation, the Soft Opening scheduled for next Thursday, Council's private tour on Monday, September 16<sup>th</sup>. Discussed what will happen to former PD.
  - Flock Safety Cameras:
    - Our trial has ended, and we have submitted our request for payment to be made. They have been incredibly successful. We are working on a presentation for the council. Chief Noble will send out the presentation before it is given to the council. Discussed annual cost, maintenance, and purchasing of cameras in future.
  - Proposed EMS Plan (Information Only):
    - Discussed proposed EMS plan for Bastrop County measure on ballot in November, which will exclude the Travis County residents of Elgin. Discussed purpose of the Letter of Intent, and what it will mean for the citizens of Elgin. It is not a contract, and it is not binding. Discussed the possibility of the committee will be doing an informational session with the community, and what the city desires in their ambulance service.
- New Business
  - Main Street Speed Limit Signs:
    - Discussed observations made about the speed limit signs, poor visibility at intersections throughout the City, traffic congestion on Hwy 95 around the middle school, and the responsibility of property owner's vs the City to

maintain visibility around the roadways/ intersections. Discussed new speed limit signs, and the possibility of a traffic study to reevaluate.

- Traffic Enforcement:
  - Discussed increased traffic enforcement, increased police presence downtown with the release of the new officers, effectiveness of recent traffic stops, new white police cars, future road construction, and the logistics of restructuring to include a Traffic Enforcement Unit.
