Speakers must address their comments to the Presiding Officer rather than to an individual Charter Review Committee Member or Staff Member. All speakers must limit their comments to the specific subject matter noted on the "PUBLIC COMMENT FORM" and refrain from any personal attacks or derogatory comments directed at any Charter Review Committee Member, Staff Member, other individual, or group.
